A HEALTHY HYPOTHALAMUS LINKED TO LONGER LIFE



Scientists have identified the hypothalamus as the part of the brain that can help us live longer and they've seen, in experiments with laboratory mice, what can happen if it starts to malfunction.

People with a healthy hypothalamus can live up to seven years longer, say scientists from Washington University in St Louis.

The hypothalamus regulates the body's organs and fat tissue that, in turn, provide feedback in a loop that is essential for energy production throughout the body. When this feedback loop starts to deteriorate, chronic health problems develop.

The scientists identified an enzyme, called eNAMPT, that fat tissue releases as part of the communication loop to the hypothalamus and that maintains strong connections to the brain.

Other ways to maintain healthy hypothalamus functioning include eating a diet of fruits, vegetables and healthy fats; supplementing with vitamins C, B1 and B2, as well as chromium and essential oils; exercising regularly; getting a good night's sleep and reducing stress levels.

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VITAMIN D DEFICIENCY LINKED TO PERIPHERAL NEUROPATHY



Vitamin D deficiency is independently linked to the risk for diabetic peripheral neuropathy (DPN) by potentially affecting large nerve fibres in older patients with type 2 diabetes (T2D).

Although previous research has shown that vitamin D deficiency is common in patients with diabetes and may increase the risk for peripheral neuropathy, its effects on large and small nerve fibre lesions have not been well explored yet.

Vitamin D3 is naturally produced in human skin in the presence of UVB light. There is a growing recommendation for 20 minutes of sun exposure daily (without sun cream but outside the intensive period of midday - 3pm), as this is estimated to produce 2,000iu of vitamin D3 in the body.

Vitamin D receptors are found on most cells in the body, including immune cells, lymphocytes and macrophages.

Vitamin D is essential for maintaining healthy bones and teeth, for normal functioning of the immune system (including the inflammatory response to wounds and infection) and for for supporting normal cell division.

Vitamin D3 deficiency is pandemic, due in part to the modern-day indoor lifestyle, to the use of sunscreen and due also to dietary changes.

It is recommended that individuals using more than 2,000iu Vitamin D per day have their blood levels monitored regularly.
